The 2021 FRINGE WORLD Festival is big variety of shows with a predominately WA program of 83% local shows along with 11% from interstate and 6% of shows from international artists whose permanent address is not Australia but who were in the country prequarantine.

FRINGE WORLD has made a range of changes to support artists and customers to engage fully in the Festival despite the COVID-19 restrictions. For artists and participants some fees have been waivered or deferred until after the Festival, and artists have greater flexibility than ever before to participate. Customers will also have peace of mind that if a show is cancelled or if they have COVID-19 symptoms they can get a refund and the Festival has a comprehensive COVID Safe Plan.

The 2021 FRINGE WORLD Festival runs January 15 January to 14 February.
